   which digs into Israeli history and
   politics, providing context for today's
   toughest questions about the Middle
   East (three cohorts met this year!)
- The Jewish Learning Fellowship
   which gave students the opportunity
   to discuss the Jewish perspective on
   life's ultimate questions and to
   investigate how Jewish values
   inform their daily lives


